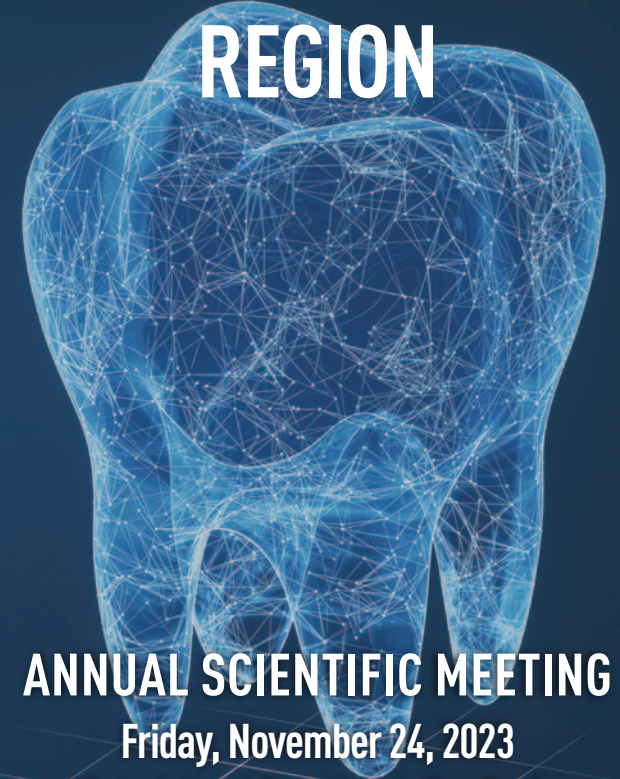

SPEAKERS

Dr Louise O'Dowd



Dr Louise O'Dowd is Specialist in Restorative Dentistry and Periodontology. She works for the University of Edinburgh at Edinburgh Dental Institute (EDI) as a Senior Clinical Lecturer and Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry. In addition, she works at Vermilion, a Private Specialist referral practice in Edinburgh, where she treats

patients with Periodontal diseases on referral. In her role within the EDI, Louise is involved with education of UG and PG trainees and has various clinical leadership responsibilities for the University and for NHS Lothian. Her clinical focus in the EDI is general restorative management of patients with complex needs who require multi-disciplinary management including Adults with Cleft.

Louise graduated from Dundee University Dental School in 2002 and obtained Membership of the Faculty of Dental Surgery (MFDS) from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (RCSEd) in 2004. She carried out Specialist Training in Restorative Dentistry at Newcastle Dental Hospital between 2006 and 2011, during which time she also completed a Masters in Restorative Dentistry. She completed a Postgraduate Certificate of Academic Practice (PgCAP) from the University of Edinburgh in 2017.

Louise is an examiner for the RCSEd for both the MDFS and the Membership of Restorative Dentistry (MRD) examination in Periodontology. She juggles work with 3 children who help to ensure there is never a dull moment!

Dr Martin Foster



Martin qualified in 1986 from Edinburgh Dental School and worked in general practice before moving into a career in the Community Dental Service which involved experience of a wide range of primary care and hospital settings, including care for maximum security psychiatric patients, sedation and anaesthetic referral services, teaching law and ethics and clinical tutoring in paediatric dentistry.

A combination of further studies and experience resulted in completion of a Master's degree in Public Health, the Diploma in Health Service Management and registration as a Specialist in Paediatric Dentistry. In addition to his clinical role, an ongoing interest in legal issues led to the completion of legal examinations as an Intranter in the Faculty of Advocates.

Martin was appointed Assistant Clinical Director with responsibility for NHS Lothian Children's Dental Service in 2007. He is a regular presenter on a range of legal and ethical issues and has a particular interest in communication and risk management. Martin maintains a weekly clinical commitment as a Specialist in Paediatric Dentistry. Martin is the DPL lead for Ireland.

Mr. Adrian Pace-Balzan



Mr. Pace-Balzan is a Consultant and Honorary Senior Clinical Lecturer in Restorative Dentistry at the Edinburgh Postgraduate Dental Institute. He graduated from the University of Malta in 1995. Following graduation he completed his vocational training and worked in both hospital and

general dental practice in Malta before moving to the UK in 2000. He held a series of junior training posts in Oral & Maxillofacial surgery and Restorative Dentistry. He undertook specialist training in Restorative Dentistry at the Edinburgh Postgraduate Dental Institute and was awarded the Certificate of Completion of Specialist Training in Restorative Dentistry (CCST) in 2010. During this time he also gained an MPhil (Liverpool) in 2006, an MClintDent (Prosthodontics) in 2008 and FDS (Rest Dent) RCPS (Glasgow) in 2010. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. He is a GDC registered specialist in Restorative Dentistry, Prosthodontics and Endodontics.

He has worked as a Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Crosshouse University Hospital (Oncology), Dundee Dental Hospital (Endodontics) and as a clinical academic consultant at the Glasgow Dental Hospital & School (Endodontics & Prosthodontics) before moving to the Edinburgh Dental Institute in 2016 where he leads the restorative service for patients with congenitally missing teeth (Hypodontia). He is also Training Program Director for the SE Scotland, and External Advisor for the Scottish Academy. He also works as Specialist in Endodontics at the Meadows Dental Clinic, Edinburgh since 2018.

Dr Christopher Millen



Chris currently works full time in specialist referral practice in Edinburgh accepting referrals for Prosthodontics, Periodontics and complex multidisciplinary cases including implants. He is a GDC registered specialist in Restorative dentistry, Prosthodontics and Periodontics. He previously worked as a

consultant in Restorative Dentistry and was the lead for Oral Rehabilitation of head and neck cancer patients in the South East of Scotland. He was awarded an ITI scholarship during his training which involved working for a year in Bern, Switzerland with the team there.
